Clinical Site Expectations

What's included in the clerkship syllabus?

- Contact info for clerkship co-directors & coordinators
- · First day logistics for each site
- Clerkship learning objectives
- Required assignments and logs
- Grading information and appeals process
- Clerkship assessment form
- · Links to CUNY SoM policies e.g., duty hours and mistreatment

What's NOT in the syllabus?

- Everything else!
- Students want to know what's expected of them regarding day-to-day clinical work e.g., how many patients should I see during a clinic session? Is there a specific format I should use for presentations on rounds? Am I allowed to do procedures in the ED? Is there a fridge I can use for my lunch?

Why not just put this other info in the syllabus?

(1) The syllabus (already ~20 pages) would get very long very guickly, and students at X site have no need for information about Y & Z sites (2) Typically we only update the syllabus at the start of the new academic year. It's much easier to make on-the-fly updates to smaller/more specific documents.
